



Esther 3:1 So what nationality was he? 1 Samuel 15:2,20 When do we first hear of them having anything to do with God's people and what were they doing? Genesis 14:7 What happened when The Israelites were in the desert? Exodus 17:8-16 - note especially what God said in verse 14 and Moses said in verse 16. What does Moses remind them at the end of the wilderness journey? Deuteronomy 25:17-19 Who also had problems with them? Judges 6:3 What did Saul fail to do? 1 Samuel 15:1-3,7-11 (1 Chronicles 4:42-43) What nation is mentioned in Psalm 83:7-8 to make you think they were still around some time later. There may be another reason for Mordecai to remember what God had said. Esther 2:5, 1 Samuel 9:1-2 (Think of his tribe)
