We will all stand before God's judgement seat ... so then, each of us will give an account of himself to God.





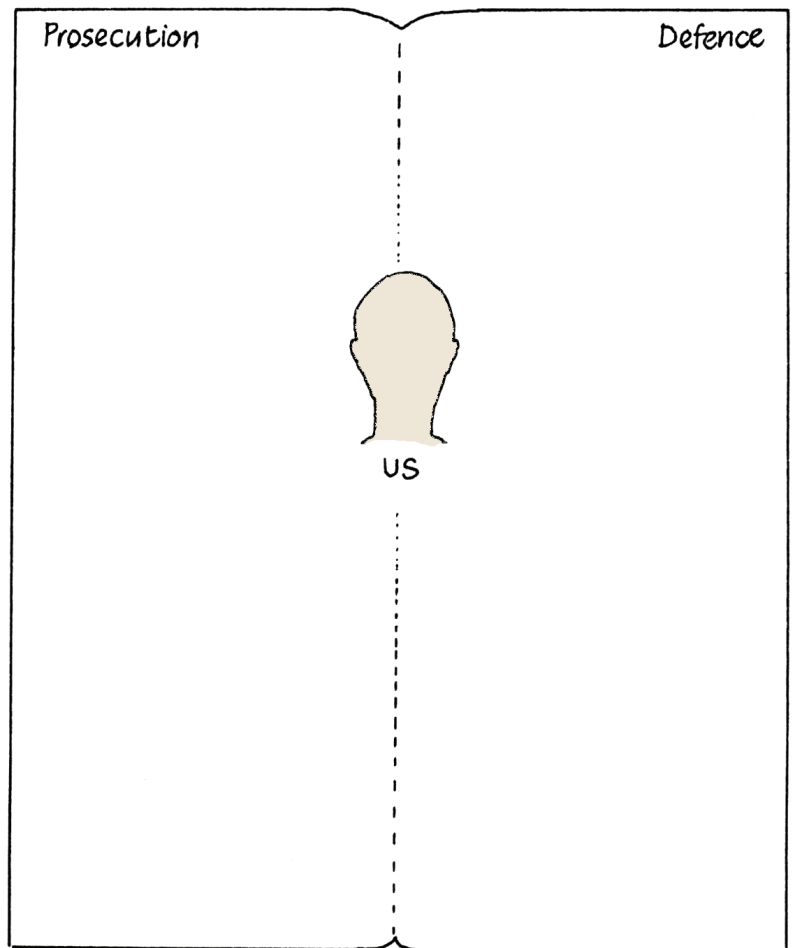
