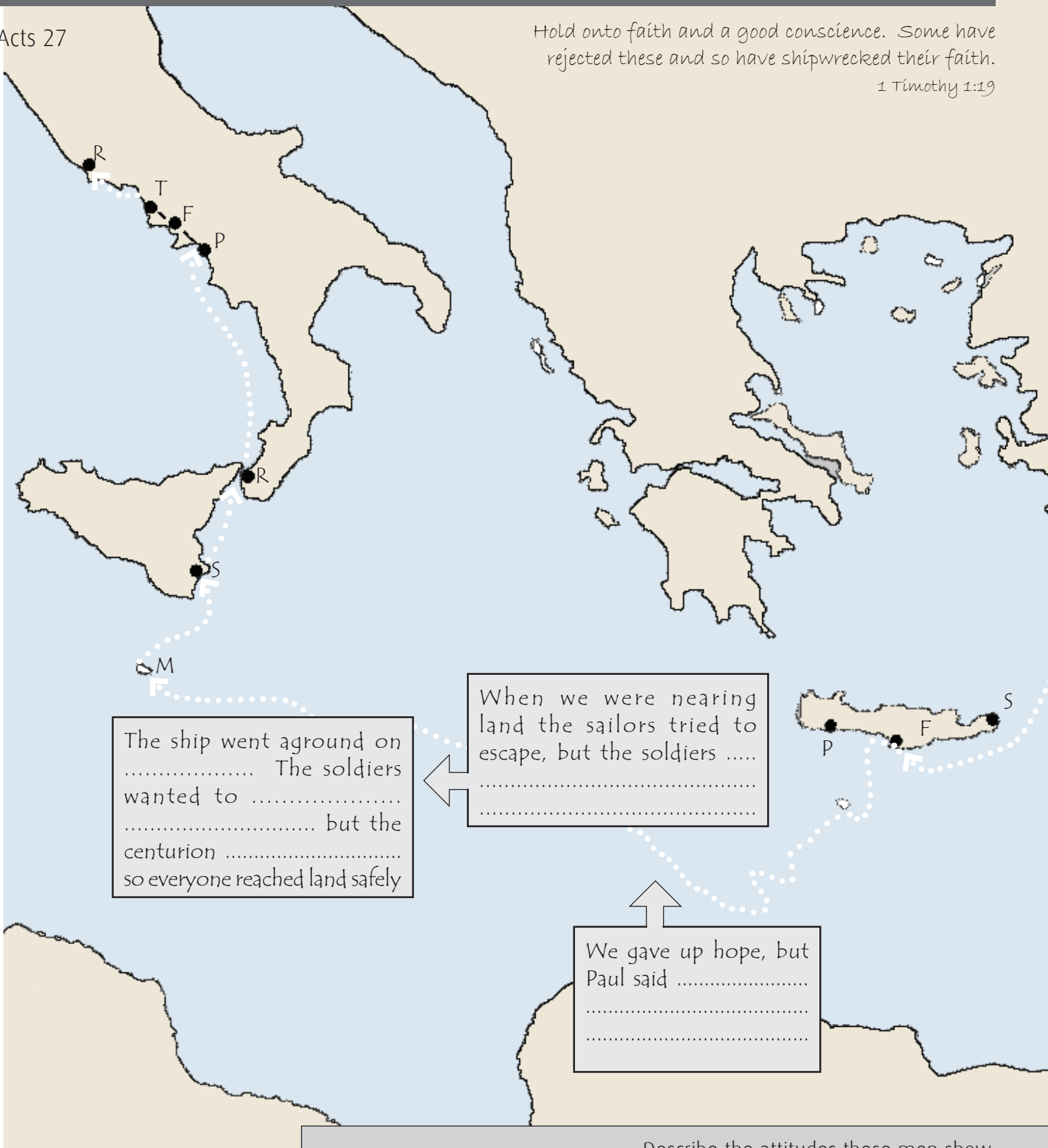


Acts 27
