Sold for 20 pieces of silver	Sold for 30 pieces of silver
Put into a pit	
Pit later found empty	Raised on the 3rd day
Went into a far country	Ascended into heaven
A faithful servant (to Potiphar)	Made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant
	Tempted in every way as we are — yet was without sin
innocent but paid the price of sin (in prison)	
	All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me
Appointed to save the world from famine	God so loved the world that He gave his one and only son
Provides bread for hungry	
Nations come to him and they are saved	in Christ there is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free...all one in Christ Jesus
Marries a Gentile wife who joins his family	
Sons of an Egyptian wife given an inheritance with Israel	Jews and Gentiles inherit the Kingdom together
