

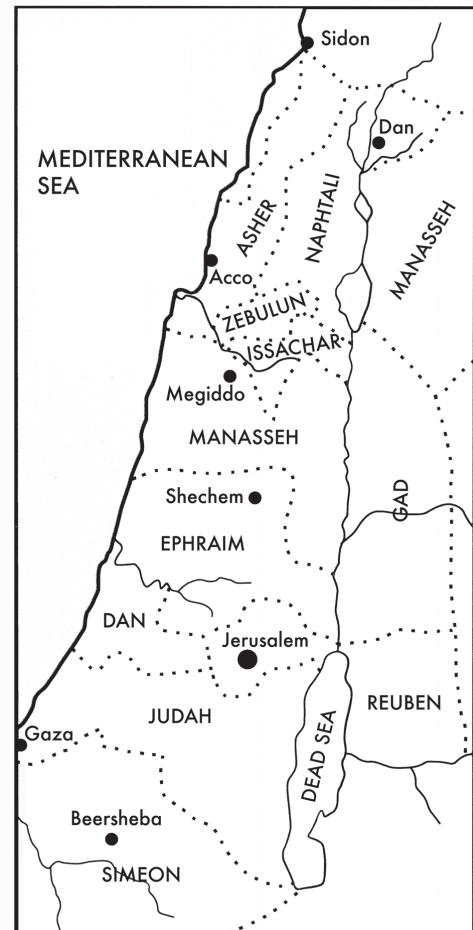
# 14 Be strong

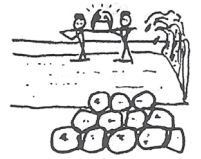
