16 Family matters - Sex and marriage

Read Genesis 2:18-24. Think about what sex is for, and how it began. Can you spot three steps in v24? See what order they're in.

For obvious reasons, much of the Bible's teaching about sex is in the context of its teaching about marriage. Think about how God wants marriage to work. Matthew 19:4-6; Ephesians 5:21-33; 1 Peter 3:1-8 may help.

And what about the sex bit? Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 7:1-7;

Think about some examples of sexual relationships which God does not allow. Why do you think that is? 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, 18-20 and Romans 1:26-27 may help.
